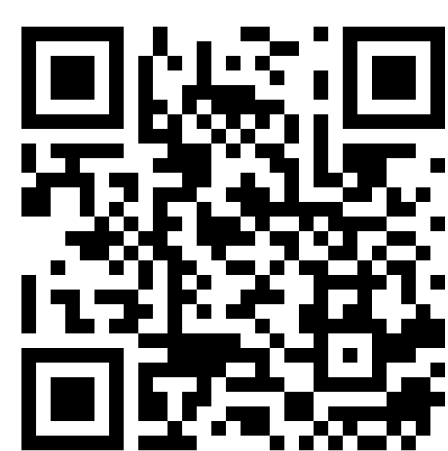

To address this issue, our faculty were desperately in need of awareness on research methodology and research metrics. 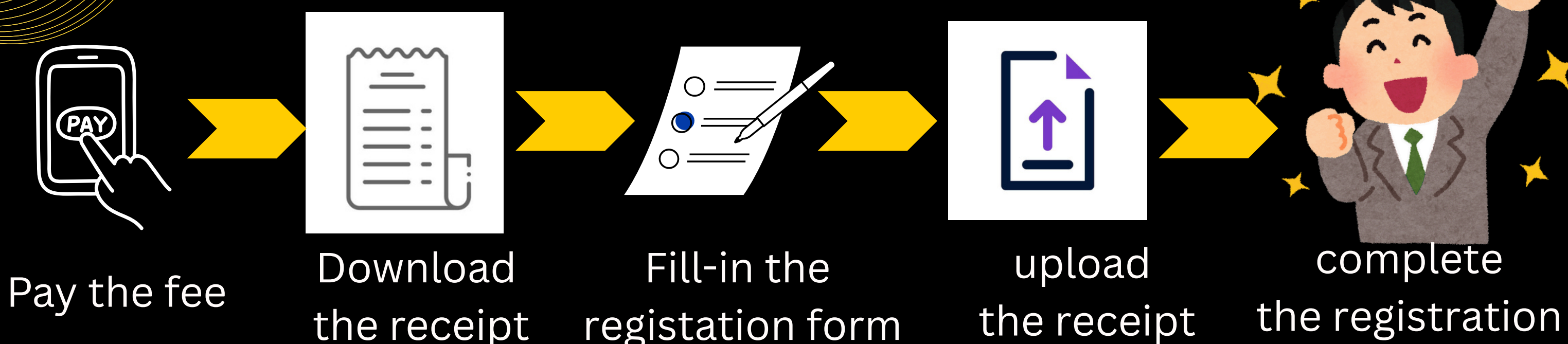
