



Exchange Admission Requirements

- 1) Completed Special/Exchange Student Application
- 2) Two Academic Reference Forms
- 3) Official College Transcripts (can be unofficial if sent directly from Study Abroad Coordinator)
- 4) English Proficiency Test Score; ONE of the following:
 - A. TOEFL iBT minimum score of 60 (score of 80 or higher for ESL course exemption)
 - B. TOEFL PBT minimum score of 15 per area (score of 20 or higher for ESL course exemption)
 - C. IELTS minimum score of 4.5 (score of 6.0 or higher for ESL course exemption)
 - D. TOEIC minimum score of 500 (score of 700 or higher for ESL course exemption)
 - E. PTE minimum score of 43 (score of 53 or higher for ESL course exemption)
 - F. iTEP minimum score of 3.0 (score of 3.8 or higher for ESL course exemption)
 - G. Other English proficiency exam/qualification specific to home university pre-approved by LETU
- 5) Proof of Finances (bank statement/letter proving the student has the funds to cover the cost of attendance)
- 6) Color Copy of Passport

Exchange Cost of Attendance

These costs apply to students whose home school has agreed for incoming exchange students to pay tuition to the home school and housing and special fees to the host school.
