Action Taken Report for the IQAC meeting held on August 3, 2020

- 1. Subsequent to the IQAC meeting held on 3rd August 2020, two Online Faculty Development Programmes were conducted by the IQAC for the Faculty of Madras Christian College. Certificates were issued for the same.
- 2. Mr. Vimal Gerald, Assistant Professor in Computer Science, St. Joseph's College (Autonomous), Tiruchirapalli, was the resource person at the first FDP on "E-Content Development' conducted from August 10 - 13, 2020. The 152 Faculty members participated in the FDP.
- 3. In the second FDP on "Training of Trainers on Outcome-Based Education", conducted on August 24 - 28,2020, the resource person Dr. C. James, Associate Professor in Physics and IQAC Coordinator of Scott Christian College (Autonomous), Nagercoil, threw light on the Essence of OBE, Learning Outcome, Instruction Alignment, Design-Down Curriculum and Outcome Assessment. Nearly 35 Faculty members were trained to be Trainers in OBE.
- 4. The Madras Christian College Research Colloquium (MCCRC) was ideated on May 12, 2020, which would function within the scope listed below:
 - a. To equip each other by enriching their research skills,
 - b. To expand interdisciplinary collaborations across the departments,
 - c. To redefine pedagogy through research-based methods
 - d. To brainstorm domain-specific administrative issues through crowdresourcing
 - To solicit innovative ideations from students as human resources.
- 5. Forty-two Online Zoom meetings were conducted by MCCRC on diverse research, publications, patenting and related aspects as required by the Accreditation and Ranking bodies, from May 2020 to August 2020, as tabulated below.
