NIRF 2020 Data is being compiled for upload and the task would be completed by February 19, 2021.

3rd National Water Award

The advertisement for the 3rd National Water Award was published on January 7, 2021. The Principal encouraged that IQAC to gather data on water conservation initiatives by Madras Christian College and apply for the same.

New Initiatives of the College

The Principal made a remark that the initiatives of the College through the Departments and various Units must be in congruence with the 7 NAAC Criteria and other ranking bodies. Based on these, the following new proposals have been ideated by the Administrators of the College under the guidance and efforts of the Principal Dr. P. Wilson.

a. Innovation Park

The Principal informed the members that a proposal to establish an "Innovation Park" on Campus was presented to the Board and seek for grants towards this futuristic dream to put the College in the Research map of the Country on par with High-ranked institutions. He said the realization of this project would make Madras Christian College, the first Liberal Arts and Science College with such a large scale, facility.

b. Ideation Club

As discussed, and proposed in the earlier IQAC meeting, the Ideation Club was formed and inaugurated on 29th Jan 2021. Mr. Steven Manuels, Talent Manager, Ford delivered the inaugural address.

Dr. P. Hanumantha Rao reported on the proposal to conduct "MCC Innovation Contest 2020-21" by the Ideation Club on 1st of February 2021 and announce the result of the content by the end of March 2021.

c. Proposal for Upskilling Programme for Non-teaching staff

The Principal Dr. P. Wilson proposed that an upskilling programme for the Non-teaching staff of the College be conducted under the auspices of the Centre for Women Studies by Dr. Anne Thomas. It was decided to have sessions on IT, Communication, Inter-personal and Office-admin skills to boost the confidence and elevate the skills of the Non-teaching staff in terms of technology and the requirements for Online administrative support.

Dr. Robinson informed the members that MCC was granted approval to run the following new programmes / courses under National Skills Qualifications Framework (NSQF) during the academic session 2020 – 2021 and the approved courses are tabulated below:
